In its second vintage, this 100% Cabernet Sauvignon is fermented in open-top stainless steel tanks and then aged in (75% new) French oak for 14 months. Possessing bravado with a focus of blackberry freshness and mocha. Dusty, plum skin tannins ride side saddle with dense notes of leather and tobacco. It's yippee ki yay on the palate with a juicy, yet muscular profile -Meredith May, *The Tasting Panel/ Somm Journal*



WINEMAKING

Ride Paso Robles Cabernet showcases a deep ruby/purple core with shaved cocoa, black fruit, cinnamon, and sweet tobacco aromas. The mouthfeel has great density and polish in the texture with incredible length. The 2021 is a rare mix of boldness and finesse.

Hand-harvested at night to ensure cool temperatures, we cold soak the berries to draw color and develop flavors while elevating structure. Fermented in open-top stainless steel tanks, then aged in French oak barrels, 75% new, for 14 months, the wine is bottled unfiltered and unfiltered.
