Dusty, plum skin tannins ride side saddle with dense notes of leather and tobacco. It's yippee ki yay on the palate with a juicy, yet muscular profile."

JEB DUNNUCK 92 pts

Jammy blackberries, black raspberries, candied orange, and floral, herbal notes all emerge from the 2021 Cabernet Sauvignon Paso Robles, another impeccably made Cabernet Sauvignon from this label. It's medium to full-bodied, has loads of fruit, good acidity, and ripe tannins, as well as tons of character. I wouldn't push the aging curve, as I love its vibrant fruit, but I see no reason this shouldn't have a solid decade of longevity.



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
